

A fun and educational photo rally to learn more about the city of Barcelona. Participants should find specific locations around the city and take their own photos.

Duration: 3 hours.

Total participants: 20 people or more.

Number of qualified instructors:

1 for every 20 participants. The teachers or people in charge of every group must take part in the activity.

Transport: Usually on foot, and in some cases the activity may include a trip on public transport (two trips per person included).

Languages: Catalan, Spanish, English and French.

Who can take part?

Groups of people **aged 12 to 16** staying at the Pere Tarrés Youth Hostel.

What it is about?

In groups of 5 or 6 people, participants have photo challenges – using their cameras (or mobile phones) they must take photos and show them at the checkpoints.

The activity also includes several group challenges to do around the city.

Urban circuits (to choose from)

South Route (3h): Plaza Catalunya. Ramblas. Gothic Quarter. Cathedral and City Hall. Port and coastal area.

North Route (3h): Plaza Catalunya. Paseo de Gracia. Casa Batlló and Casa Milà. Sagrada Familia.

Other routes: Montjuic and Olympic area circuit. Camp Nou and Tibidabo area circuit. Beaches and Forum area circuit.
