The FESTSPT offers an International Pack of courses for incoming undergraduate students during the 1st and the 2nd semester. These courses will be taught in Spanish except for two of them, *Perspectives on social innovation* 1 *and* 2 (offered during the 2nd semester), which will be taught in English. Two modalities are offered:

Accomodation

FESTSPT does not have a residence building for its students. Students are responsible for finding their own accommodation in Barcelona.
