Language requirements	<p style="text-align: center;">The recommended language level is: B2 in Spanish or Catalan The minimum language level for the acceptance is: B1 in Spanish or Catalan</p> <p>The language certificate has to be submitted together with the application form. If the certificate is not provided with the application form, the application will be rejected.</p> <p>The certificates accepted for the accreditation of the language level are:</p> <p>Spanish language: DELE score, minimum of B1 CELU score, minimum of B1. Certificates from the home institution stating the students have a B1 in Spanish or Catalan will also be accepted.</p> <p>Catalan language: Institut Ramon Llull Certificate, minimum of B1. Certificates from the home institution stating the students have a B1 in Spanish or Catalan will also be accepted.</p>

	<p>Exemptions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students from Catalan or Spanish-speaking countries are exempt from sending a Spanish certificate. Students who have followed the previous years of their Bachelor Degree with Spanish as the sole language of instruction are exempt from sending a Spanish certificate, but they have to give proof their Bachelor Degree is fully taught in Spanish. Students who have attended high school in Spain and taken the courses in Spanish are exempt from sending a Spanish certificate, but they have to give proof they attended high school in Spain. <p>Please, remember:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the student wants to apply for the modality with internship, a B2 level of Spanish will be required. If the student is taking a course taught in English at least a B1 level of English will be also required. The certificates accepted for the accreditation of the English language level are: • IELTS score of at least 4.5 on average. • TOEFL scores of at least 60 (Internet-based). • University of Cambridge Certificates (PET, FCE, CAE or CPE).

<p>Passport ID Visa</p>	<p>All students must have a valid passport or ID document. For EU citizens, an ID card is sufficient. Passports and ID documents must be valid for the duration of your stay.</p> <p>Students from outside EU may need a Student Visa: it must be obtained before arriving to Spain. <p>Insurances</p>	<p>Exchange students must have a health and a liability insurance covering them for their whole mobility period in Barcelona Spain.</p>	

	<p>Accepted exchange students will have to send an scanned copy of their insurance(s) prior to their arrival in Barcelona to: international@peretarres.org.</p> <p>The Insurance documents will have to be in Spanish, Catalan or English. You have to make sure the insurance clearly states that you are covered for health and social liability. Exchange students will not be enrolled at our institution without the corresponding insurance(s).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ EU citizens: for the health insurance, students have to present the European Health Insurance Card in the country of origin or a private insurance. ▪ Non-EU citizens: students need to contract a private insurance with no limit of reimbursement for the entire mobility period. <p>Accidents and repatriation insurances are highly recommended but not mandatory. In case you have them, send them as well.</p> <p>URL has an agreement with Oncampus, an insurance company offering specific insurances to incoming students at reduced prices. <p>Accommodation</p>	<p>FESTSPT does not have a residence building for its students. Students are responsible for finding their own accommodation in Barcelona, nevertheless, the URL collaborates with BCU Barcelona University Center, which offers a wide range of accommodation, especially for international students in temporary stays. We strongly recommend exchange students to use this official resource, in order to avoid potential scams.</p> <p>Look for your accommodation through BCU Barcelona University Center: BCU is an organization created in 1997 to facilitate the non-academic life of international students. Through collaboration with public institutions and universities, it helps to find accommodation (residencies, apartments, etc.) and offers complementary services such as airport pick-up and legal advice.</p> <p>You can check all the information in their website: BCU Barcelona University Center. Contact: info@bcuhousing.cat</p> <p>For a room in a shared apartment, a range from 400€ to 600€ is considered normal, depending on the square meters and location. Rooms in Residence Halls are usually a little more expensive, between 600€ to 1000€.</p> <p>If you are looking for a cheap and well-located place to stay during your first days in Barcelona, while looking for more permanent accommodation, the Pere Tarres Foundation has a youth hostel close to the train station Barcelona Sants, it is well communicated with public transportation Youth Hostel Pere Tarrés: https://www.peretarres.org/en/barcelona-hostel</p> <p>Besides, the Erasmus+ App provides top tips to students and offers accommodation options, allowing peer-to-peer support for Erasmus students.</p>

- Modality WITH internship: courses/lectures (15 ECTS) + Practicum V (fieldwork of 200h) (15 ECTS)
