<b>Medical and repatriation Insurance</b>	EU citizens: students need to get their European Health Card in the country of origin. Non-EU citizens: students need to contract a private insurance with no limit of reimbursement for the entire mobility period.  It is strongly recommended for all students to have a repatriation insurance.

### Accommodation

FESTSPT does not have a residence building for its students. Students are responsible for finding their own accommodation in Barcelona.
