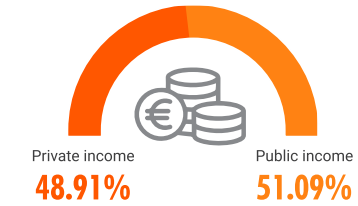

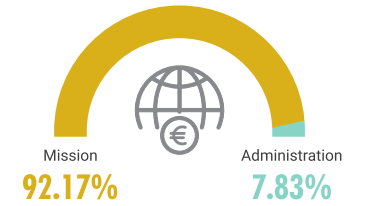

How we obtain our income



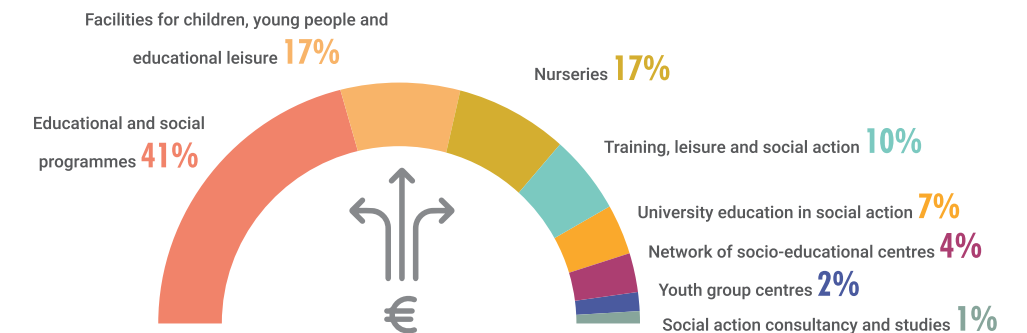
