When you have received, you feel a moral obligation to give. Giving was my way of showing gratitude



A child whose life was full of difficulties and challenges walked through the door of a small premises in the heart of Sant Adrià de Besòs for the first time. The place was neither luxurious nor large, but it was full of life and possibilities. There he found something he had never felt before: people who looked him in the eye and saw all his potential. **That child was me.**

In that space I discovered that hugs can heal, that a smile can save your day, and that when someone believes in you, **you learn to believe in yourself.**

I grew up and, after going around a lot, one day I returned to that small premises. And I felt once again that immense joy of knowing that the place was still there, waiting for me and welcoming me back.

Like many other children and young people, I stayed there: first as a volunteer and now, after training as a social integration worker, as a member of staff at the centre.

Today I support children and families carrying backpacks full of problems they did not choose: poverty, violence, discrimination, neglect, loneliness...

Children who arrive with their heads down and sadness in their eyes, and who little by little raise them again because we tell them:

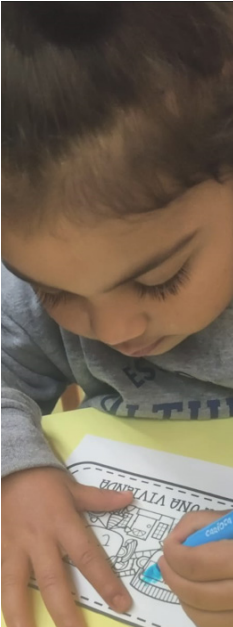
“Here, you truly matter.”

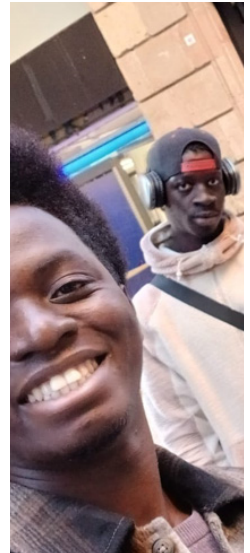

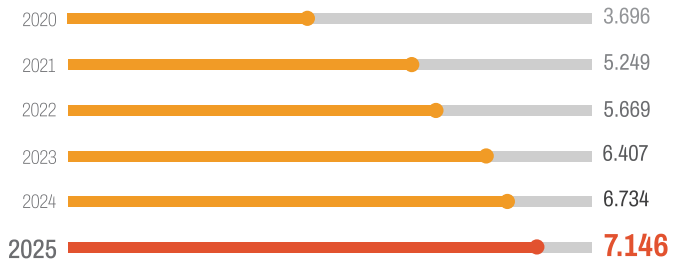

WE TRANSFORM

Caring for the **oral health** of children and young people

This year, thanks to our collaboration with various dental clinics, 378 children and young people from our social and educational centres were able to access oral health check-ups, and 47 of them received treatment for different oral pathologies. The campaign aims to ensure good detection and treatment of these conditions and, at the same time, to promote oral health prevention.

Solidarity toys



Once again, the “Transform Their Christmas” campaign collected games, toys and educational materials so that 3,446 children and young people from vulnerable families could also experience the magic of the festive season. The initiative was made possible thanks to the support of 25 companies, institutions and individual citizens.

The Poble-sec Social and Educational Centre **expands its capacity**



This year, our Poble-sec Social and Educational Centre in Barcelona opened new premises provided by the parish of Sant Salvador d'Horta, doubling its capacity. This has enabled us to improve and unify the socio-educational activity, which had previously been spread across two separate sites, and to expand capacity. This academic year, the centre can already support up to 200 children and young people.

Eye tests and glasses for children in the Raval

Some ophthalmological treatments are a significant expense for vulnerable families. Thanks to the partnership with Fundació Ètnia, around fifty children and young people from the Raval Social and Educational Centre took part in free eye examinations. With the support of volunteer professionals and the Faculty of Optics and Optometry of Terrassa and Institut Salvador Seguí, vision problems were detected and corrected, providing glasses at no cost to families.



Healthy afternoon snacks thanks to the Food Bank and partner companies

Almost 2,000 children attending our social and educational centres are able to enjoy fresh seasonal fruit and healthy afternoon snacks every day thanks to our collaboration with Fundació Banc dels Aliments and with various partner companies committed to improving the nutrition of the children we support.



Attention to children and young people's mental health



14% of the children attending our centres have mental health disorders, although educators estimate that the real figure could be much higher. We identified this after carrying out our own study, which concludes that socio-economic vulnerability is a trigger for mental health problems. The report points to proposals such as training or incorporating specialised psychologists into the centres.

€69,000 raised in solidarity to improve educational activity in Sant Adrià

Once again, we held our solidarity dinner, a project led by the Friends of Fundació Pere Tarrés Association, which raised €69,000 thanks to the involvement of 69 companies and individual donors. The funds raised will be used to improve the educational and social work of our Sant Adrià Social and Educational Centre through the purchase and refurbishment of new premises.

A child should be able to go to camp



I am a single working mother, and I did not want my son to be out on the street when I was away from home. He now goes to the Raval Social and Educational Centre of Fundació Pere Tarrés, and I am very happy because they are there for everything:

there is educational support, and if you need help with paperwork, they help you too.

For example, four years ago I became unemployed after having worked for twenty years as a shop assistant. I did not know how to write a CV, and Anna, the centre director, helped me.

They also run zumba classes for mothers, Quim **has had eye tests, and they helped us by providing him with glasses free** of charge.

What's more, last summer he went away for five **days to camp**. I could not pay for all of that myself, and they are experiences he needs to have. A child should be able to go to camp.

I always tell my son that he has to do three things:

be happy, go to school and go to the Raval Social and Educational Centre.
